## CASTLEMAINE'S BEGINNINGS

The Dja Dja Wrung people have been custodians of the area in which Castlemaine now stands for many centuries. European occupation dates back to the 1830s and 40s when pastoral holdings were taken up. Gold was found in 1851, triggering a gold rush and Castlemaine became the centre of the Mount Alexander goldfields. By 1860 local government was well established, substantial buildings and private homes were built and major industries serving goldmining and surrounding communities had developed.
